This parole petition has been filed by the petitioner with a prayer that his brother Anil @ Lalee S/o Daleep Kumar may be released on parole for 20 days in accordance with the Rajasthan Prisoner's Release on Parole Rules, 1958.

In the application, it is submitted that earlier D.B. Civil Writ (Parole) Petition No.4180/2014 was filed by Anil @ Lalee S/o Daleep Kumar in which an order was made on 04.08.2014, whereby while rejecting the parole petition an order was made to reconsider the prayer of the petitioner and the liberty was granted to the petitioner to move an application afresh for grant of parole after a period of six months.

The submissions of the petitioner is that after passing aforesaid order, an application was filed by the petitioner afresh but respondents are not granting parole to his brother Anil @ Lalee S/o Daleep Kumar.

In the reply filed by the respondents, it is submitted that the case of Anil @ Lalee S/o Daleep Kumar for granting him parole of 20 days was considered by the District Level Parole

Committee in its meeting dated 30.03.2015, but rejected on the ground of adverse report.

We have perused the reasons incorporated in the order. In our opinion, at this stage, brother of the petitioner Anil @ Lalee S/o Daleep Kumar is not entitled for granting parole of 20 days due to reasons incorporated in the order.

Hence, this parole petition is dismissed. However, the petitioner is at liberty to file fresh application again after lapse of one year.
