The present application has been filed alleging violation of the order of the Court dated 25.10.2011 passed in CWJC No. 18920 of 2011 by which the writ petition was disposed off in terms of the order

dated 28.06.2011 passed by a Division Bench of this Court in L.P.A.No. 831 of 2009.

It appears that L.P.A.No. 831 of 2009 was disposed off by a common order along with other cases including CWJC No. 6144 of 2011.
