Heard learned counsel, Mr. R. Dutta for the petitioner and learned Addl. G.A., Ms. A.S. Lodh for the State-respondents.

The grievance of the petitioner is that he joined Police Department of Government of Tripura, as a Sub-Inspector of Police on 09.09.1981 and thereafter he was posted in different organ of the Police Department at different places time to time. He is a permanent resident of West Tripura District and he was transferred to Khowai District on 21.01.2012. He is due to retire on 30.11.2018.

It is the case of the petitioner that as per the guide line issued by the Director General of Police, dated 22.10.1999 (Annexure-E to the writ petition) it was decided that Officers/men of all rank will be considered for posting to their home District or District of their choice in the last three years prior to their superannuation subject to availability of vacancies. The petitioner is due to retire on 30.11.2018. He made a representation to his superior authorities through Superintendent of Police, Khowai District and his application for transfer was forwarded by Superintendent of Police with a request to consider it. A copy of the forwarding letter of the Superintendent of Police, Khowai is annexed as Annexure - H i.e. letter No. 2619/F.24/SP/RSV/KHW/15 dated 18.04.2016.

It is submitted by learned counsel, Mr. Dutta that the representation of the petitioner though has been duly forwarded by the Superintendent of Police, Khowai District on 18.04.2016 has yet not been considered by the superior authority of the Police i.e. Director General of Police, even after issue of lawyer@@@@@s notice.

Learned counsel, Mr. Dutta therefore submits that the writ petition may be disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the representation of the petitioner which is forwarded by Superintendent of Police, Khowai District within a short possible time so that the petitioner may avail the home facility in the fag end of his carrier.

Learned Addl. G.A., Ms. Lodh submits that the writ petition may be disposed of with a direction to dispose the representation of the petitioner.

Considering the submission of learned counsel of both side and considering the materials placed on record, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent Nos.1 & 2 to consider and dispose the representation of the petitioner sympathetically in accordance with law within 30 days from today.

The petitioner is at liberty to submit a copy of the representation along with copy of this order to respondent No.2 at the earliest.

Copy of this order be supplied to learned counsel of the parties on payment of usual cost. The writ petition accordingly stands disposed of.
