Heard Mr. DC Roy, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner as well as Mr. A. Ghosh, learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the State.

This is an application under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C in connection with Baikhora PS case no. 2016/BKR/055 under Sections 448/354 of the IPC.

After going through the complaint, it appears that the petitioner may be granted pre-arrest bail with certain conditions to protect the interest of the investigation. The petitioner is, therefore, enlarged on pre-arrest bail in connection with the said case and as such in the event of the arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing a bail bond of Rs.20,000/- supported by one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting police officer subject to the condition that the petitioner shall report to the Officer-i--Charge, Baikhora police station or to the Investigating Officer once in a week for the next 3(three) months and he shall not make any attempt to influence or coerce the witnesses or the persons who are seized of any information which is relevant for the investigation. Moreover, the petitioner shall not leave his original place of residence, as described in the petition without leaving any information to the Investigating Officer. Accordingly, this petitioner stands allowed.
