Heard Mr. S.Lodh, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner as well as Mr. A.Ghosh, learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the State.

This is an application filed under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C for pre-arrest bail of the accused petitioners inconnection with Airport PS case no. ARP 044 of 2016 under Sections 417/376/506 of the IPC.

Mr. Lodh, learned counsel has submitted that there is no ingredient of any offence against the present petitioners and he has referred the written ejahar filed by the victim and on examination thereof this Court does not find any allegation against the petitioners. Mr. Ghosh, learned Public prosecutor has fairly submitted that the State does not have any opposition if the petitioners are granted pre-arrest bail in connection with that case. In the event of arrest of the petitioners, the petitioners shall be enlarged on bail on furnishing a bail bond of Rs.10,000/- each supported by 1(one) surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting police officer. The petitioners shall appear in the police station or shall not resist their examination by the police officer for the purpose of investigation. They shall not leave their original place of residence, as described in this application, without leaving prior information to the Investigation Officer. Accordingly, this petition stands allowed subject to the conditions, as stated above.
