This is an application filed on behalf of respondents No. 2 to 5 for striking off respondent No.1, Union of India.

Learned counsel for non-applicant/petitioner submits that she does not wish to file reply to the application.

Learned counsel for respondents submits that respondent No.1, Union of India is not a necessary party in terms of the Notifications dated 21.01.2016 and 29.01.2016 issued by Employees Provident Fund Organisation.

Learned counsel for non-applicant/petitioner submits that she has no objection if respondent No.1, Union of India is struck off from the array of parties.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case and submissions made by learned counsel for non-applicant/petitioner, respondent No.1 Union of India is deleted from the array of parties. The petitioner is directed to file amended memo of parties.

Accordingly, Misc. Case (WPC) No. 156 of 2016 stands disposed of.
