Learned counsel for the respondents submits that as per his instructions, the prayer made by the petitioner in this writ petition for promotion to the rank of Subedar Major (SKT) has already been granted by the Department and necessary order in that regard has been issued on 29.06.2016. The learned counsel has placed the copy of the order for perusal of the Court. However, looking to contents of the order dated 29.06.2016 where some of the basic criteria were required to be fulfilled by the petitioner before his actual joining in the rank, the learned counsel for the respondents was queried as to whether the order has in fact been carried out and the petitioner has been allowed to join the promotional rank? Learned counsel for the respondents, after taking instructions, submits that the petitioner has indeed joined the promotional rank.

Though the learned counsel for the petitioner submits want of instructions, but in view of categorical statement made by the learned counsel for the respondents, this petition could only be treated as infructuous.

This petition is, therefore, dismissed as infructuous but while providing that in case of any grievance remaining yet, it shall be permissible for the petitioner to take recourse appropriate remedy in accordance with law.

A copy of the said order dated 29.06.2016 shall be properly placed on record by the learned counsel for the respondents.
