Learned counsel for the petitioner frankly submits that so far the principal subject matter of this writ petition, i.e., the order of suspension of the petitioner from the office of headman, is concerned the cause cannot be considered surviving because the period for which the petitioner was appointed has already come to the end. The learned counsel, however, attempts to submit that the respondent – KHADC should take appropriate steps for filling up the office at the earliest.

So far this petition is concerned, it could only be considered redundant with the cause neither surviving nor calling for any adjudication.

So far the other steps by the respondent – KHADC are concerned; it goes without saying that KHADC and all related authorities are expected to act in accordance with law. No other writ, order or directions at this stage appears requisite in this petition.

With the observation foregoing, this petition stands disposed of.
