Heard Mr. K.S.Kynjing, learned Sr. Counsel, assisted by Mr. P.T.Sangma, learned counsel for and on behalf of the petitioner who submits that inspite of the judgment and order passed by the Hon'ble High Court dated 27-05-2013 passed in WP(C) No. (SH) 79/2013, the respondents in violation of the said judgment adopted a different methodology which is not acceptable. Learned Sr. Counsel also further contended that the records of the Akhing land in question is available in the office of the District Council, so they have to decide the matter on the basis of the records available in the office after giving opportunity of hearing to both the parties. So, necessary direction maybe passed.

On the other hand, Mr. S.Dey, learned counsel for the respondents-GHADC submits that they are taking steps only on the basis of the judgment and order given by the Hon'ble High Court referred above and they are not including anything new.

If this is so, I am of the considered view that the matter can be disposed of at this motion stage with the following direction.

Respondents-GHADC are directed to dispose of the matter on the basis of the documents and records available in their office and after giving full opportunity of being heard to the parties and strictly to follow the judgment and order dated 27-05-2013 referred above.

With this observation and direction, the writ appeal is allowed to that extent and stands disposed of. Registry is directed to furnish a copy of this order to Mr. K.S.Kynjing, learned Sr. Counsel for the petitioner as well as Mr. S.Dey, learned counsel for the respondents-GHADC positively by Monday.

Matter stands disposed of.
