Heard Ms. U. Das, learned counsel for the petitioner as well as Mr. S.P. Choudhury, learned counsel representing all the respondents.

Grievance raised is in respect of the order dated 14.06.2016 and the subsequent issuance of the Movement Order dated 25.06.2016, whereby the petitioner has been directed to report to the Commandant, 230 Bn, CRPF. The primary ground assigned is that the petitioner has been advised to take rest for the period from 20.06.2016 to 21.07.2016 on account of the fact that he had undergone laparoscopy operation of his gall-bladder. This Medical Certificate has been issued by the CRPF authority. Considering his indisposition, the petitioner have also made a representation before the Director General of Police, Group Centre, CRPF, P.O. Amerigog, Kamrup praying for grant of 30 days medical leave.

Having regard to the parameters and scope of this Court to make interference in a transfer/movement order, this Court is not inclined to grant relief to the petitioner, save and except, directing the Director General of Police, CRPF to look into the representation filed by the petitioner on 22.06.2016 and to pass appropriate order thereon.

In view of the above, this writ petition does not stand for further consideration and is accordingly disposed of. However, it is made clear that the representation filed by the petitioner shall be considered and disposed of within a period of 2 (two) weeks from today.
