1. 1<sup>st</sup> Petitioner working as lecturer in Chemistry and 2<sup>nd</sup> petitioner working as lecturer in Physics at Government Higher Secondary School (Boys) Kishtwar by the impugned order No. 1083-DSEJ of 2016 dated 26.03.2016 have been transferred to Higher Secondary School Bala and Higher Secondary School (boys) Binoon. Their grievance is that the place to which they have been transferred to do not have the post commensurate with their subject in which they are teaching and no purpose will be served by their posting on such places.
2. Considering this interim order dated 06.04.2016 passed by this Court in which specific direction was given to the respondents to accord consideration for transferring the petitioners to other available posts in respective subjects, that order has not been complied so far.

3. Today when the matter is taken up, Mr. Ravinder Gupta, learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the respondents states that final order could be passed by this court directing the authority to accord consideration to the request of the petitioners based on the representation.
4. On file there is no representation made by the petitioners. In this view of the matter no purpose will be served by keeping the writ petition pending.
5. Hence the Court is inclined to direct both the petitioners to give representation(s) to the concerned authority-Director School Education Jammu projecting their grievance within two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order. The Director School Education Jammu-respondent No. 2 shall pass appropriate orders thereon within a period of two weeks thereafter.
6. The Writ petition is disposed of as above.
