2/29.2.2016 All these three applications arise out of the same case and as such, they are being disposed of by this common order.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.

The petitioners have been made accused in connection with Rania P.S case No. 11 of 2015 corresponding to G.R No.135 of 2015, for the offence under Sections 302, 201 / 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Dead body of an unknown person was recovered and the case was instituted against unknown.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case only due to suspicion and has prayed for bail.

Learned counsel for the State has opposed the prayer for bail, submitting that the family members of the deceased have stated that they had learnt that the petitioners had taken away the deceased along-with them, but due to their fear, nobody was ready to disclose the offence. Subsequently, the dead body of the deceased was found.

Learned counsel for the State has opposed the prayer, but it is admitted from the case diary that there is no eyewitnesses in the case. It is also submitted that the confessional statement of the petitioner, Jonson Guria @ Mangra had led to the recovery of a stolen motorcycle.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioners, Nirbandh Guria @ Sukhwa, Ojha Guria and Jonson Guria @ Mangra, on bail. Accordingly, the petitioners, named above, are directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Khunti, in connection with Rania P.S case No. 11 of 2015, corresponding to G.R No.135 of 2015.
