The petitioner has been made accused for the offences under Sections 452, 307, 302 / 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25(1-B)(a) and 35 of the Arms Act, in connection with Pakur (T) P.S. Case No. 169 of 2012 corresponding to G.R. No. 485 of 2012, S.C. No. 200 of 2013.

This is a case of contract killing and the father of the informant was assaulted by firearm by two unknown persons and while they were fleeing away, one of the assailants was apprehended, whereupon, he fired pistol on the person, who had apprehended him, causing his death and both of them managed to flee away. The petitioner was the person, who had fired the pistol. Bail applications of this petitioner were earlier rejected thrice on merits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has renewed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

In the facts of this case, I am not inclined to reconsider the prayer for bail of the petitioner, Raju Choudhary. Accordingly, his prayer for bail is rejected.
