04 / 29.04.2016. Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners, who are accused for offence under Sections 379, 411 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, Section 30(ii) of Coal Mines Act and Section 33 of Indian Forest Act pra for anticipatory bail expressing apprehension of their arrest in connection with Mandu (Kuju) P.S. Case No. 409 of 2015.

It appears that the prosecution case was lodged by self-statement of one Ramchandra Sah, ASI who was posted at Kuju O.P., alleging therein, that information was received by him that one truck was parked in which 18 tonnes Pora coal had been loaded.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 is the proprietor of M/s Gautam Industries and the petitioner No.2 is the registered owner of the truck, in question and submitted that all bona-fides papers were there, but the same were not being considered by the trial court.

It was further stated that factory of the petitioner No.1 is also registered under the CST Act. It was further submitted that after verification, papers were found genuine.

Regard being had to the facts and circumstances, the petitioners, above-named, are directed to surrender themselves

before the court below within three weeks from today, and on their surrender, they shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM, Ramgarh, in connection with Mandu (Kuju) P.S. Case No.409 of 2015 arising out G.R. No. 4220 of 2015, on the condition that one of the bailors should be local resident of Ramgarh District and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
