The petitioner is an accused for the offence registered under Section 302 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is in custody since 15.06.2014. That charge has been framed and altogether seven witnesses including the informant have been examined and none of the witnesses has supported the prosecution case. It is submitted that the informant has not made any incriminating statement against the petitioner as would be evident from the certified copies of the deposition of the witnesses examined . That the petitioner is languishing in custody without any material on record.

Learned A.P.P has opposed and submitted that trial is in progress.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State and going through the deposition of the witnesses, the petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sessions Judge, Lohardaga in connection with S.T.NO.141/2014(arising out of Lohardaga P.S.Case No.64/2014 on the condition that he shall remain physically present in the court below as and when required till the conclusion of the trial.
