Petitioners are accused in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 272/273/420 of the Indian Penal and also under Section 47(A)/49 of Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case. Petitioner no.2 is the son of the petitioner no.1. They are innocent and the police has instituted a false and fabricated case as against them. It has further been submitted that the house where the raid was conducted does not belong to the petitioners rather the same is in the name of co-accused Basant Mandal and petitioners are merely the tenants. They have nothing to do with the recovered liquors. Moreover, both the petitioners are in judicial custody since 22.09.2016.

Learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioners.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the petitioners, named above, are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Godda in connection with Godda (T) P.S. Case no. 217 of 2016 corresponding to G.R. no. 1245 of 2016.
