The petitioners are accused in a case registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 324, 325, 304, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act and later on Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code was also added.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case and have committed no offence as alleged in the first information report. So far as Petitioner No.1 is concerned, there is allegation against him that he was holding the deceased, namely, Irshad Ansari @ Raju. Even as per the first information report, the Petitioner no.1 has not given any blow on the deceased. So far as Petitioner No.2 is concerned, though his name has been given in the first information report, yet there is no allegation at all against him in the written report of the informant. The petitioners are in judicial custody since 26th August, 2016.

Learned counsel for the State opposes the petitioners' prayer for bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioners, above named, are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand), each, with two sureties of the like amount, each, to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, Ranchi, in connection with Pithoria P.S. Case No.69 of 2016, corresponding to G.R. No.3482 of 2016.
