03/30.07.2016 The sole petitioner Subheshwar Prasad Verma @ Sudeshwar Mahto @ Subheshwar Prasad has moved this Court for grant of regular bail in connection with Giridih (M) P.S. Case no. 652 of 2014 instituted under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 324, 307, 427, 504, 302 of the Indian Penal Code.

Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner as well as learned A.P.P. appearing for the State.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that though the petitioner is named in the FIR, but there is no allegation of assault against this petitioner rather the specific allegation of assault is against the other co-accused persons upon the informant and his wife and for no fault on his part, the petitioner has been languishing in jail custody since 24.02.2016. It was also submitted that one of the similarly situated co-accused has already been granted regular bail by the another Bench of this Court vide order dated 09.03.2016 passed in B.A. No. 1506 of 2016. Hence, the petitioner also deserves to be released on bail.

Learned A.P.P. representing the State though opposed the prayer but fairly submitted that similarly situated co-accused has been granted regular bail.

Considering the submissions of the counsels and the facts and circumstances of the case stated above, I am inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the Court below is directed to enlarge the petitioner, above named, on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M., Giridih in connection with Giridih (M) P.S. Case no. 652 of 2014 corresponding to G.R. No. 3467 of 2014.
