Perused the office note dated 27.08.2016, it appears that Defect no. 4 i.e. authentication fee due on the copy of trial court judgment Rs. 20/- and defect no. 9 (ii) i.e. page nos. 25 & 26 are not complete, have not been removed.

2. In view of the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner, defect no. 9 (ii) is hereby ignored.

3. Further, it is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that he has deposited the court fee of Rs. 20/- on 11.08.2016.

4. Office is directed to trace out the court fee and tag it on the record of the case.

5. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned APP for the State.

6. Petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Seraikella P.S. Case No. 52 of 2016, corresponding to G.R. No. 297 of 2016, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 34 of the I.P.C.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has been implicated in this case due to village politics. It is further submitted that ration card was issued in his name after necessary enquiry and verification by the government officials. Neither the cards were filled by the petitioner nor the declaration papers contain his signature. It is submitted that co-accused Nuna Ram Mahato, Parmeshwar Mahato and Chanda Devi were granted anticipatory bail by this Court in A.B.A. No. 2001 of 2016 and A.B.A. No. 2020 of 2016 on 19.08.2016.

8. Be that as it may, I am inclined to admit the petitioner on anticipatory bail. The petitioner, above named, is directed to surrender in the court below within two weeks from the date of this order and in the event of his arrest or surrender the court below shall enlarge the above named petitioner on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten

thousand), with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Seraikella, in connection with Seraikalla P.S. Case No. 52 of 2016, corresponding to G.R. No. 297 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
