Petitioner is an accused in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 452/376 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3,4,5 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act 2002 in connection with Adityapur (R.I.T.) P.S. Case No. 169 of 2013, corresponding to G.R. No. 716 of 2013 (S.T. No. 15/2014) pending in the court of learned Addl. Sessions Judge-I, Seraikella.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and there is no cogent evidence as against him for implicating him in the present case. In fact he has not committed any rape upon the victim girl as alleged by the informant (mother of the victim girl).

On the other hand, learned A.P.P. while opposing the prayer for bail submits that there is a serious allegation against the petitioner for committing rape upon the minor girl. Moreover, victim girl has also supported the case of the prosecution in her statement recorded under Section 164 of the Cr. P.C.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, I am not inclined to enlarge petitioner above named on bail. Accordingly, prayer for bail of the petitioner above named is rejected.
