Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Baharagora P.S. Case No. 13 of 2016, corresponding to G.R. No. 80 of 2016, for the offence registered under Sections 406, 420, 120B, 34 of the I.P.C r/w under sections 177, 140 (ii), 179, 190, 192(A) 66(i) of M.V. Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. No offence under the alleged sections is made out against the petitioner. The petitioner is not named in F.I.R and the petitioner has been implicated in this case only on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused.

Learned A.P.P has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, the above named petitioner is directed to surrender in the Court below within four weeks from the date of this order and in the event of his arrest or surrender the Court below shall enlarge him on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand), with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Court of Sri S.A. Prasad, learned J.M. Ist Class, at Ghatshila in connection with Baharagora P.S. Case No. 13 of 2016, corresponding to G.R. No. 80 of 2016, subject to conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.PC and also subject to the condition that one of the bailors must be local resident of Ghatshila, sub-division subject to the condition that petitioner shall deposit Rs. 11,000/- before the Secretary, Jharkhand High Court Advocates Association and file a receipt to this effect before this Court.
