04/ 29.01.2016 Counsel for the opposite party submits that a compliance report has been filed on 10.12.2015 enclosing a reasoned order dated 12.10.2015 passed in compliance of the order under offence. As per the reasoned order, a sum of Rs. 13,08,641.00 has been found to be admissible against the various post retirement and service dues. Payments are to be made in installment of Rs. 50,000/- per month, as per the scheme framed for the retired employees of MADA keeping into account the weak financial condition of the organization.

2. As per the reasoned order, petitioner may file an objection before the competent authority under MADA within a period of 15 days, if not satisfied with the computation of the amount.

3. However, petitioner is at liberty to file objection if not satisfied. It is pointed out that if installments are not being paid within time, petitioner may be given liberty to approach this Court once again. It goes without saying

4. In that view of the matter, contempt petition is disposed of. Proceedings are dropped.
