Order dated 30.03.2009 passed in W.P(S) No 2925 of 2003, breach thereof has been alleged by the applicant, discloses that the Writ Court directed the opposite parties to consider the case of the writ petitioner for appointment in accordance with the Recruitment Rules, if vacancies are available and he is otherwise eligible. In the show-cause reply the opposite parties assert that representation of the applicant was disposed of intimating him that in case an advertisement is issued and he applies for appointment on the post of Accounts Officer, his candidature would be considered in terms of Recruitment Rules.

Since there is no mandatory direction issued by this Court to grant appointment to the applicant, in view of the show-cause reply filed on behalf of the opposite parties, the present contempt case is dismissed.
