The petitioner has been made accused for the offence under Sections 302, 201 / 34 of the Indian Penal Code, in connection with S.T. No. 46 of 2015, arising out of Nimdih P.S. Case No. 54 of 2014 corresponding to G.R. No. 1149 of 2014.

The case relates to murder of the cousin of the informant, who according to the FIR had gone from his the house with this petitioner. From the FIR, it also appears that subsequently the dead body of the deceased was found.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case only due to suspicion and has accordingly, prayed for bail.

Learned counsel for the State has opposed the prayer for bail, but upon going through the case diary, it is admitted that on the basis of confessional statement of the co-accused, there is recovery of motorcycle of the deceased and one *bhujali*. It is also admitted that against this petitioner, there is nothing specific except the confessional statement of the co-accused.

In the facts of this case, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner, Bharat Gope, on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand), with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-II, Seraikella, in connection with S.T. No. 46 of 2015, arising out of Nimdih P.S. Case No. 54 of 2014 corresponding to G.R. No. 1149 of 2014.
