The petitioner has been made accused for the offences under Sections 395, 364-A and 412 of the Indian Penal Code, in connection with Kuru P.S. Case No. 91 of 2012 corresponding to G.R. No. 461 of 2012, S.T. No. 165 of 2015.

The case relates to dacoity and kidnapping / abduction of two brothers of the informant for ransom. The case was instituted against unknown.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and other co-accused persons, who had faced trial have already been acquitted after trial. The Judgment of the Trial Court has been brought on record.

In the facts of this case, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner, Sandeep Bhagat, on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand), with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Addl. Sessions Judge-II, Lohardaga, in connection with S.T. No. 165 of 2015, arising out of Kuru P.S. Case No. 91 of 2012 corresponding to G.R. No. 461 of 2012.
