The petitioner has been made accused for the offences under Section 427 of the Indian Penal Code, Sections 3, 4 of the Explosive Substance Act, Section 13(1) of the U.A.P. Act and Section 17 of the C.L.A. Act, in connection with Bishunpur P.S. Case No. 38 of 2009 corresponding to G.R. No. 925 of 2009.

FIR was lodged against unknown extremists for destroying the building of primary health centre by explosion.

In the facts of this case, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner, Bineshwar Sahu, on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand), with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gumla, in connection with Bishunpur P.S. Case No. 38 of 2009 corresponding to G.R. No. 925 of 2009.
