**02 / 30.07.2016** The sole petitioner has moved this court for grant of regular bail in connection with Patratu P.S. case no. 273 of 2015 instituted under sections 25 (1-b)a/26/35 of Arms Act and also under Section 17 CLA Act.

Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner as well as learned Addl. PP for the State.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that one country made pistol and four live cartridges were recovered from the possession of this petitioner. Learned counsel further submitted that the petitioner has committed no offence as alleged and he has been falsely implicated in this case but even then, the petitioner has been languishing in jail custody since 10.12.2015. Hence, he deserves to be released on bail.

Learned counsel representing the State opposed the prayer.

Considering submissions of learned counsels and the facts as stated above, I am inclined to release this petitioner on bail. Hence, the court below is directed to enlarge the petitioner on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.D.J., III, Ramgarh in connection with Patratu P.S. case no. 273 of 2015 corresponding to G. R. No. 4523 of 2015.
