

08. 29.09.2016 Heard learned counsels for the parties.

This writ petition pertains to inter se seniority in between the petitioner and opposite party no.4.

Learned counsel for opposite party State has submitted that the writ petition may be disposed of directing the petitioner to approach before the Director, Higher Education, Orissa along with relevant document to be enclosed with appropriate representation and if the authority will be approached, he will take decision in accordance with law regarding the issue involved in this writ petition.

Learned counsel for petitioner has raised no objection.

Considering the submissions and without entering into the merit of the claim of the petitioner and on consent of the parties the writ petition is disposed of giving liberty to the petitioner to approach before the Director, Higher Education, Orissa to raise his grievance with respect to seniority which he has claimed in this writ petition by filing appropriate representation with all relevant documents within three weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and if such representation will be filed, the Director, Higher Education, Orissa shall issue notice to the opposite party no.4 (whose counsel is present and has submitted that he has no instruction), verify the relevant documents and after providing opportunity of hearing to the parties shall pass order in accordance with law within reasonable period, preferably within ten weeks from the date of such representation.

With the above observations and directions the writ petition is disposed of.
