

ABLAPL No.13725 of 2016

31.08.2016 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Government Advocate.

The petitioner is apprehending arrest for the alleged commission of offence under Sections 20(b)(ii)(C) and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act in T.R. No.31 of 2016 of the court of learned Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Koraput, arising out of Padwa P.S. Case No.40 of 2016.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has allegedly committed the offence punishable under the N.D.P.S. Act, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. However, keeping in view submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the bail application is disposed of granting liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the learned Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Koraput in the aforesaid case within twenty-one working days hence and pray for bail. On such event, his bail application shall be considered and disposed on the same day.

The ABLAPL is disposed of accordingly.
