The petitioner having been implicated in Bhadrak Rural P.S. Case No. 524 of 20 16 corresponding to G.R. Case No. 1689 of 2016 on the file S.D.J.M., Bhadrak for alleged commi ssion of offence under section 47(a) of the Bihar & Orissa Excise Act, has filed this applicat ion for grant of anticipatory bail.

Considering the submissions and viewing nature of accusations against the petitioner, while being not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, it is directed that in the event the petitioner surrenders in the court below within two weeks hence and move s for his release on bail, the same shall be considered on its own merit and disposed of in accordance with law, further taking into account the factum of release of the co-accused person on bail and if similarly situated on the ground of parity as per law, during the first hour so as to enable the petitioner to approach the next higher forum during the second half of the day in case necessity so arises.

The ABLAPL is accordingly disposed of. Urgent certified copy of this order be granted on proper application.
