The petitioners are in custody as accused in G.R. Case No.690 of 2015 on the file of le arned S.D.J.M., Koraput registered under Sections 498-A/304-B/302/34, I.P.C.

It has been alleged that the present two petitioners assisted the father-in-law of the deceased to inject some medicines into her body, which ultimately resulted in her death.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that absolutely they have no relation with the family being outsiders. In the meantime, charge-sheet has already been submitted in the c ase and the petitioners are in custody since July, 2015.

Learned counsel on behalf of the State submits that the Viscera Report, as called for, has not yet been received.

It is further submitted on behalf of the petitioners that they have been implicated in the case basing on the statement of the father-in-law of the deceased, who is a co-accused in this case.

Considering the submissions and the circumstances, it is directed that let the petition er be released on bail by furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/-(rupees twenty thousand) each with two sureties for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned S.D.J.M., Koraput in the afor esaid case with the conditions that they shall not default in personal attendance of the court during trial at least on two consecutive dates.

The Bail Application is accordingly disposed of.
