Applicant apprehends arrest in connection with offences punishable u/S. 420, 467, 468 and 471 of IPC registered as Crime No.11/2016 at Police Station Crime Branch, Gwalior, District Gwalior.

Learned Public Prosecutor for the State opposed the application and prayed for its rejection by contending that on the basis of the allegations and the material available on record, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

The applicant apprehends arrest in respect of cheating and forgery on the factual allegation that discovery of the co-accused-Rajeev Gogela recorded u/S. 27 of the Evidence Act. The applicant has been implicated and it is said that he is part of the racket involved in preparing of forged mark-sheets which were verified and found to be fake.

In view of the above and since, investigation is still pending and custodial interrogation assumes relevance. Looking to the nature of the offence, no case for bail is made out.

Accordingly, first bail application u/S.438 of Cr.P.C is hereby rejected.
