This is an application under section 438 Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in connection with Crime No.59/2016 registered at Police Station, Barod, district Agar for the offence punishable under section 406 I.P.C.

As per prosecution case on 13.03.2015 the tractor bearing registration No.MP-13-AB-9084 belonging to the wife of the complainant was taken away by the accused for the purpose of cultivation and sold the same to Udaisingh & Shankarlal.

Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that applicant has not committed any offence and he has been falsely implicated in the offence. He further submits that investigation in the matter is over and prays for grant of anticipatory bail since the applicant

would face social ostracism and embarrassment, if he is arrested.

Prayer is opposed by the counsel for the respondent/State.

Considering overall facts and totality of the circumstances and the nature of offence, the application allowed and it is directed that in the the applicant event of arrest of with connection the aforesaid crime number, he shall be released on bail upon his furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.

This order shall be governed by the conditions No.1 to 3 of sub section (2) of section 438 Cr.P.C.
