This Writ Petition has been filed by the petitioner aggrieved with the construction of the road on the land of the petitioner without acquiring it and without paying any compensation.

When the matter is taken up today it is pointed out that petitioner has already approached the Collector vide representation dt. 22/12/2015 and the same is pending before the concerned Collector respondent No.2 and no decision has been taken on it till now.

Learned counsel for the respondent State submits that petitioner's representation will be duly considered and decided by the respondent No.2 and appropriate decision will be taken.

In these circumstances, without adverting to the merits of the matter, the Writ Petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to take appropriate decision on the petitioner's pending representation mentioned above within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. The petitioner to submit a fresh copy of the representation along with certified copy of this order. In case if the petitioner is found entitled the necessary benefit will be extended to him in accordance with law without any unnecessary delay.
