This is repeat bail petition under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for grant of bail. Applicant – Jai Singh is in custody since 08/01/2016 in connection with Crime No.12/16 registered at Police Station-Annapurna, District-Indore for the offences punishable under Sections 354A, 354-D, 147, 148, 452, 458, 506 of IPC and under Sections 25, 27 & 30 of the Arms Act.

His first application for grant of bail has been dismissed vide order dated 15/02/2016, passed in M.Cr.C. No.1028/2016.

Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the present applicant is having complete parity with co-accused Akash, whose bail bail application has been allowed by this Court today i.e. on 30.04.2016 in M.Cr.C. No.2475/2016 and prays that on the ground of parity with co-accused Akash, this repeat application for grant of bail of the present applicant be allowed and he be released on bail.

On the other hand, learned Panel Lawyer for the non-applicant/State opposed the prayer and prays for its rejection.

On due consideration of the nature of allegation levelled against the present applicant so also the period of custody of the applicant, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, on the ground of parity with aforesaid co-accused Akash, I allow the bail application and it is directed that the applicant be released on bail subject to his furnishing a personal bond in a sum of Rs.30,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the concerned JMFC/CJM, for his appearance before him or trial Court, as the case may be, on all dates of hearing as may be fixed in this behalf by the Court concerned during trial.
