The petitioner before this Court has filed this present writ petition stating that respondent Nos. 5 to 10 are trying to take possession of the land belonging to the petitioner and the petitioner has submitted a representation to the Collector and nothing is being done.

This Court is of the considered opinion that in case the respondents have taken possession of the land of the petitioner, the petitioner does have a remedy to file Civil Suit claiming possession. Not only this, the provisions of M. P. Land Revenue Code, 1959 also provides a remedy to the petitioner.

This court does not find any reason to interfere in the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case.

Accordingly, the admission is declined.
