This is first application filed by the applicant under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail as he apprehends his arrest in connection with crime No. 23/2016, registered at Police Station- Malazkhand District- Balaghat against him for the offence punishable under Sections 120-B, 193, 420, 467 and 468 of the IPC & Section 3(1)(viii)(ix) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act.

The allegation against the applicant is that he had induced Yaman Singh to take permission to cut certain trees, however, it is mentioned in the order that the trees were never cut.

Learned Panel Lawyer appearing on behalf of the State has admitted the fact that the trees were never cut and there was no illegal falling of trees.

Looking to the nature and facts of the case, the application is

allowed. It is ordered that in the event of arrest of the applicant in

connection with the aforesaid crime number and the offences,

applicant be released on bail on his furnishing a personal bond in

the sum of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) with

one solvent surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the

Investigating Officer/ Arresting Authority.

The applicant is directed to join the investigation immediately

and to cooperate with the investigating agency. He will further

abide by the conditions enumerated in sub-Section 2 of Section

438 of the Cr.P.C.
