This is the first bail application under Section 438 Cr.P.C filed by the applicant for grant of anticipatory bail.

Applicant is apprehending his arrest in connection with Crime No.112/2015 registered at Police Station Jiyavan Deosar, Singrauli for the offences under Sections 498-A/34 of the IPC and Sections 3/4 of Dowry Prohibition Act

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the applicant contends that the applicant is mother-in-law of the complainant. She is a teacher and working in the Swami Narayan Sanskirt Mahavidhyalaya Dabhad Nadiad (Gujrat). She has filed the copy of ration card and Adhar Card. It is stated that it is a case of false implication to the entire family of members. However, the present applicant is apprehending her arrest without having any connection of offence, however, prayer is made to enlarge the applicant on anticipatory bail.

On due consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court deems it proper to grant anticipatory bail to applicant **Shyama Devi**. She is directed to join the investigation immediately and fully cooperate with the investigating agency and the trial. In the event of arrest, the applicant shall be released on bail on his furnishing a personal bond in sum of **Rs.30,000/-** with a separate surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting officer. Conditions of Section 438(2) shall apply on the applicant during currency of bail.
