Regard being had to the similitude of the issue involved, at the joint request of the parties, matters were analogously heard on admission.

Learned counsel for the petitioners advanced singular contention. He submits that in view of recent order passed in W.P.No.7933/2015 (Dilip Tiwari Vs. State of M.P and others), the impugned order dated 07.07.2015 (Annexure P/9) may be set aside and petition may be disposed of in terms of the order passed in Dilip Tiwari (supra).

During the course of arguments, Shri Verma contends that petitioner will file a detailed representation along with judgment of Dilip Tiwari (supra) and submit it before respondents No.2 to 4. The said respondents be directed to decide the said representation by taking into account the recent order passed in Dillp Tiwari (supra).

Shri Kushwaha, PL has no objection to this innocuous prayer.

Accordingly, these petitions are disposed of by reserving liberty to the petitioner to file separate representation along with copy of the order passed in Dilip Tiwari (supra) before the said respondents. In turn, said respondents are directed to consider and decide the same in accordance with law expeditiously.

Petitions are disposed of without expressing any view on merits.
