*(GYAN SINGH Vs THE STATE OF MADHYA PRADESH)*

Heard.

This is repeat application filed under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for grant of bail to the applicant who has been arrested in connection with Crime No. 95/2010 registered at P.S. Parwalia, District-Bhopal for the offence punishable under Sections 420, 476, 468 of the IPC.

Earlier application was dismissed vide order dated 08/07/2016 passed in M.Cr.C. No. 7547/2016 with liberty to file the same after three months.

The allegation against the applicant is that he had sold his land and thereafter, he prepared a forged Bhu-Adhikar Pustika and thereafter, entered into a contract with another person (complainant) to sell the land.

The prayer for bail is opposed by learned Panel Lawyer.

Looking to the aforesaid facts and nature of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this application is allowed.

It is directed that on furnishing a personal bond in the sum of **Rs. 50,000/- (Rs. Fifty Thousand Only)** by the applicant along with one solvent surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial court, the applicant be released on bail with a direction to appear before the trial court on the date of the trial.

The applicant shall abide by the following conditions of **437 (3) of Cr.P.C.** as under:-

- (a) that such person shall act in accordance with the conditions of the bond executed under this Chapter,
- (b) that such person shall not commit any offence similar to the offence of which he is accused, or suspected, of the commission of which he is suspected, and
- (c) that such person shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court

or to any police officer or tamper with the evidence.
