(MADAN GOPAL SAINI Vs THE STATE OF MADHYA PRADESH)

This petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been filed seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus and directing the respondents to extend the benefit of Kramonnati under the time bound promotion scheme dated 19.04.1999 in the light of the judgment of ***K.L. Asre Vs. State of M.P & another*** in W.P. (S) No. 1070/2003 decided on 17.11.2005.

At the outset learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to grievance of the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted a representation Annexure P/2 to the respondent No.3 the Executive Engineer, Public Works Department, Jabalpur. It is therefore, prayed that the petition be disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P/2) submitted by the petitioner in the light of the judgment of ***K.L. Asre Vs. State of M.P & another*** in W.P. (S) No. 1070/2003 decided on 17.11.2005 within stipulated time period.

Learned Government Advocate appearing on behalf of respondents/State submits that appropriate decision shall be taken on representation submitted by the petitioner in accordance with law expeditiously.

In view of aforesaid submissions made by the counsel for the parties, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P/2) submitted by

the petitioner in the light of the judgment of ***K.L. Asre Vs. State of M.P & another*** in W.P. (S) No. 1070/2003 decided on 17.11.2005 within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order passed today, by speaking order. It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case.

With the aforesaid, the petition filed by the petitioner stands disposed of.
