JUDGMENT

Today, when the matter came up for hearing, there is no representation for the plaintiff.

2. The matter is pending for ex-parte evidence from 11.08.2015. Several adjournments granted by the learned Additional Master III, for recording evidence, but the plaintiff has not given his evidence. When the matter came up before this Court on 22.11.2016 also, there was no representation from the plaintiff side. Even today there is no representation for the plaintiff.

3. The conduct of the plaintiff in failure to tender his evidence, clearly shows that he is not interested in prosecuting the suit, moreover the suit is also of the year 1996. Therefore, this Court is not inclined to grant any further time. Hence, the suit is dismissed for default. No costs.
