Habeas Corpus Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for a Writ of Habeas Corpus, directing the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent to produce the body of the detainee, namely, Bhavani, D/o.Madhanagopal, aged about 21 years, before this Court forthwith and to set her at liberty.

O R D E R

(Order of the Court was made by M.JAICHANDREN,J)

This Habeas Corpus Petition has been filed, by the father of the detainee, praying that this Court may be pleased to issue a Writ of Habeas Corpus, to direct the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent to produce his daughter, namely, Bhavani, aged about 21 years, before this Court, and to set her at liberty.

2. The petitioner is the father of the detainee. He has stated that, his daughter, namely, Bhavani, who was studying in B.Sc. (Zoology) at Quaid-e-Milleth College of Arts and Science, Chennai, has been found missing, since, 26.03.2016. The petitioner has stated that the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent has abducted her and he is keeping her in illegal custody. Therefore, he had lodged a complaint before the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent police, on 27.03.2016. The said complaint had been issued with C.S.R.No.131/2016. However, as no effective steps have been

taken by the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent police, to trace the detainee, based on the complaint given by the petitioner, he has preferred the present Habeas Corpus Petition, before this Court.

3. Mr.V.M.R.Rajentren, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent, had submitted, on instructions, that the detainee has eloped with the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent, therefore, the father of the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent has preferred a complaint before the, K-9, Thiru-Vi-Ka Nagar Police Station, Chennai, in connection with which a case, in Crime No.260 of 2016, for ''Man Missing'' has been registered.

4. In such circumstances, we find it appropriate to close the Habeas Corpus Petition, as no further orders are necessary, at this stage. Hence, the Habeas Corpus Petition is closed. However, the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent shall continue the investigation and trace the missing detainee and to take necessary steps in accordance with law.
