Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

In FIR No.40 dated 28.03.2009, under Sections 323, 324, 34 and 326 (added later on) of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station City, District Hoshiarpur, the accused is being prosecuted. The parties have arrived at compromise (Annexure P-2) in order to live in peace and harmony.

In my opinion the parties can be allowed to compound/compromise. This Court had ordered the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hoshiarpur to record the statements of the parties. Now there is a report received from the Chief Judicial Magistrate that compromise has been found to be genuine and without any coercion or pressure.

In that view of the matter, FIR No.40 dated 28.03.2009, under Sections 323, 324, 34 and 326 (added later on) of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at

Police Station City, District Hoshiarpur, is quashed by way of compounding/compromise along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
