private respondents are not accepting the marriage of the petitioners and are

extending threats to them. The copy of Birth Certificate of petitioner No.1

(Annexure P-1), copy of Educational Certificate of petitioner No.2

(Annexure P-2), copy of marriage certificate (Annexure P-3) and marriage

photographs (Annexure P-4) of the petitioners have been placed on record.

Without going into the validity of the marriage, the present

petition is disposed of with the directions to the petitioners to contact

respondent Nos.2 and 3, who, after their satisfaction that the petitioners are

actually facing threat, shall take necessary steps to protect the life and liberty

of the petitioners from private respondent Nos.4 and 5, as per law.
