Revision was preferred before the Sessions Judge, Dehradun challenging the summoning order passed by the learned Magistrate on a complaint filed under Section 138 N.I. Act. Learned Revisional Court, vide order dated 21.01.2016, was pleased to issue notice on the application seeking condonation of delay in filing the revision. However, learned Revisional Court did not stay the further proceedings of the complaint.

In the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, I direct that Revisional Court shall make every endeavour to decide the application under Section 5 of the Act preferably within 30 days from the date of service of notice on the respondents.

Meanwhile, further proceedings before the learned Magistrate shall remain stay.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.

IA No. 589 of 2016 also stands disposed of accordingly.
