1. The applicant before this Court has been made an accused by the respondent no. 2 – Vinesh Chauhan. Consequently, First Information Report was filed by respondent No. 2 – Vinesh Chauhan under Section 406 of I.P.C. at Police Station Ranipur, District Haridwar. Subsequently, after investigating the case, the Police submitted the charge sheet against five persons, including the present applicant under Sections 407/120-B/201 & 411 of I.P.C. before the court concerned. The applicant has now preferred the present application under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. invoking inherent jurisdiction of this Court.

- 2. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, no interference is being made in the present matter as far as the proceedings are concerned.
- 3. In case, the applicant appears before the trial court and moves an application for bail before the Magistrate concerned, the bail application shall be considered, as far as possible on the same day itself, in accordance with law.
- 4. With the aforesaid observation, the application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. stands disposed.
