Supplementary affidavit is taken on record. Misc. application no. 3496 of 2016 made therefor is disposed of.

Applicant Amar Singh @ Bona and Rocky, who are in jail in connection with FIR no. 270 of 2015, under Section 392 IPC, registered at Police Station, Khatima, District Udham Singh Nagar, have sought their release on bail.

Heard learned counsel for the parties, considered the grounds taken up in the bail application and perused the documents brought on record.

An FIR was lodged against unknown miscreants for the offence punishable under Section 392 IPC, alleging therein that unknown miscreants snatched the bag containing money from the hands of the father of the informant.

The incident allegedly took place on 26.11.2015 and the accused-applicants were arrested on 22.01.2016 and since then both of them are in jail. It is the submission of learned counsel for the applicants that the applicants have no previous criminal history.

Learned counsel for the applicants submitted that the applicants are ready to furnish reliable sureties to the satisfaction of the court concerned, if they are granted bail.

Considering the entire conspectus of things, a case of bail is made out in favour of the present applicants.

The bail application is allowed.

Let the applicants be released on bail on their each executing a personal bond and furnishing two reliable sureties, each of like amount to the satisfaction of the court concerned.

If at any point of time, it is found that the applicants are misusing the bail, the learned Sessions Judge / trial court shall be at liberty to cancel their bail, in accordance with law.
