Applicant-Vikramjeet Singh seeks bail in connection with F.I.R. No.201 of 2015, under Sections 392, 411, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC, P.S. Gadarpur, District Udham Singh Nagar.

Heard learned counsel for the parties, considered the grounds taken up in the bail application and perused the documents brought on record.

An FIR was lodged on 01.11.2015 against the unknown miscreants for the offence punishable under Section 356 IPC alleging therein that the miscreants snatched the chain of the wife of the informant. The applicant is in jail since 09.11.2015 and has previous criminal history, but is not a previous convict.

Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant is ready to furnish reliable sureties to the satisfaction of the Court concerned, if he is granted bail.

Bail application is allowed.

Let the applicant- Vikramjeet Singh be enlarged on bail on his executing a personal bond and furnishing two <u>reliable</u> sureties, each of the like amount, to the satisfaction of the Court concerned.

If at any point of time, it is found that the applicant is misusing the bail, the learned Court below shall be at liberty to cancel his bail, in accordance with law.
