The First Information Report has been lodged by respondent no. 3, which has been registered as Case Crime No. 110 of 2016, under Section 386 of IPC, at Police Station-Ranipur, District-Haridwar against the petitioner. Apprehending his arrest, the petitioner has approached this Court for relief.
- 5. The petitioner has demanded extortion from the complainant/respondent no.3. Learned counsel for the complainant/respondent no.3 submits that petitioner has long criminal history of similar offences, a fact which is admitted by the learned counsel for the State.
